The Arkady Fomin Scholarship
Fund (AFSF) was created in 2015 to
celebrate and perpetuate the legacy and
spirit of Arkady Fomin – renowned
violinist, beloved teacher, conductor,
and longtime member of Dallas
Symphony. Mr. Fomin leaves behind a
formidable legacy of students and
colleagues from around the world who
recognize his special gift for guiding
those who approached him towards
finding their way in life and music. His
inspiration has touched the lives of
hundreds of artists, including many of
today's top performers.

Our scholarships

The AFSF awards educational scholarships to talented college and pre-college musicians from around the world, mentoring their artistic development, and supporting them in the most formative years of their lives – just as Arkady did during his tenures as Artistic Director of the New Conservatory of Dallas and also the Conservatory Music in the Mountains Festival in Durango, Colorado.

Our award stipends are intended to assist the student with their participation in masterclasses or at summer festivals.

Once an award is presented, the AFSF closely follows the student's artistic development for the purpose of providing them with important career connections and guidance.

Additionally, recipients may be invited to participate at the North Shore Chamber Music Festival in Chicago or other events presented by The Music Makers around the world.

Selection Process

AFSF Awards are given on a rolling basis and through a non-competitive process. Interested students of music who would like to apply should prepare the following:

- Biography
- Letter stating specifically what the applicant will accomplish with funds received.
- Letter of recommendation from the applicant's teacher or mentor.
- Unedited video not longer than 15
 minutes of applicant performing
 repertoire of their choice. The video
 may be submitted as a web link
 using Dropbox or Google Drive, a
 YouTube link, or an attached file.
